Terms and Conditions

Families, couples and individuals are welcomed to Plas y Cadno Camping, however under 18 year olds **must** be accompanied by an adult.

The campsite owners reserve the right to refuse admission, or ask campers who do not comply with their Terms & Conditions to leave.

For your safety, to reduce danger from fire and to avoid overcrowding, you must leave a 6 metre gap (20 feet) between each tent, even if the tent next to you is yours! You can measure this by approximately 7 good strides. You will be asked to move your tent(s) if they are too close together.

Open fires are not permissible but you are welcome to bring charcoal or gas barbeques, provided they are raised off the grass and suitably sited away from tents, and that they are attended so that they are not a hazard to other campers.

Please ensure you bring rubbish bags with you and take your rubbish away with you. There are no facilities on the field to dispose of rubbish – however there are recycling facilities behind the Victoria Hall, in the centre of town, for glass, cans and plastic.

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, and owners must clean up after their dogs. Failure to comply will result in you being asked to leave the campsite.

What we expect from users:

- Respect the campsite and its amenities, other campers and their property.
- Avoid excessive noise at all times, especially between the hours of 22:00 hrs and 07:00 hrs when others might be sleeping (those who do not comply will be asked to leave the site).
- Pitch tents at least 6mtr away from your nearest neighbour, as explained above.
- Clear away all rubbish and leave the area in a clean, tidy state.
- Be especially careful that no broken glass is left in the area.
